The more specific answer: motivated subcontractors with the below prerequisites who have not taken the steps to become certified. Businesses that are at least 51% owned, managed and controlled by U.S. citizens with affiliation in one of the following minority affinity groups:

- -African-American
- -Hispanic-American
- -Native American
- -Asian-Pacific American
- -Asian-Indian American
- -A business that is at least 51% owned, operated and managed by a woman or women

-A for-profit business that is at least 51% owned, managed, controlled and operated by a Veteran or Service Disabled Veteran

Certification is only the beginning

As part of our Supplier Diversity initiative to help increase awareness of the MWVBE certification program and the benefits businesses receive through certification, we have established a Supplier Diversity Certification Mentoring Program designed to help existing USM subcontractors becoming certified. This program will assist these contractors in obtaining certification – then, after receiving MWVBE certification, contractors are offered a comprehensive Mentoring Program that helps guide them confidently through the procurement process.
